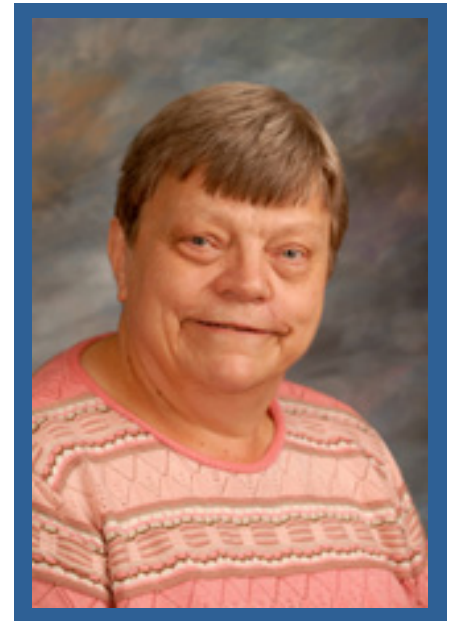

Sister Jeanne devoted the first 13 years of her ministry as a classroom teacher in Minnesota and North Dakota, following her first profession in 1968. The longest of these assignments was at St. Andrew School in St. Paul, where she taught from 1977-1982. Over the next five years, she served in elementary administration at St. Mathias in Hampton, Minnesota, and St. Peter in Canby, Minnesota. Following two years' service in Savage and Lakeville, Minnesota, Sister Jeanne returned to administration, serving at Annunciation School in Minneapolis through 1991. From 1992-1996, she served in volunteer ministry at Mankato's Welcome Inn. During this period, she also served her SSND community as a transportation coordinator for sisters residing at Our Lady of Good Counsel. Since 1996, she has ministered full-time as Justice & Peace Coordinator at Our Lady of Good Counsel. She earned a bachelor's in elementary education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee, and holds a master's in private school administration from the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul.
